Certification Process

Attend HBSS training, pass the written exam and sign the Code of Ethics to become certified. Those that are certified are recognized locally for their knowledge of effective implementation strategies for construction site stormwater pollution prevention and weekly inspections. Their name will also be added to the HBSS Certification List on IowaStormwater.org.

The Recertification Process

The recertification process is easy, attend the first half of training event every 3 years to remain in good standing with the HBSS Program (No exam).

Cancellation Policy

Full refund or credit of registration fee if cancellation notification is received three or more working days prior to event; 50% refund if notice is received less than three working days prior to event and no refund or credit is given for no notification / no-shows the day of event except in extenuating circumstances. Registration is transferable.
